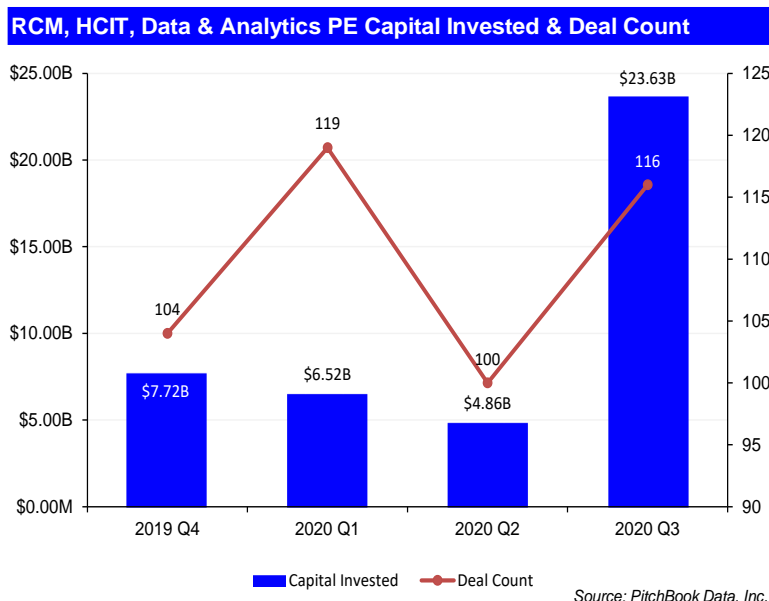

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A big topic of focus in the last few months has been SPACs. They have become extremely popular in 2020. They represent private companies move for exit opportunities amidst the uncertainty created in the IPO market by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The number of SPAC IPOs in 2020 has already more than doubled the 2019 year totals. Notably, Bill Ackman raised a \$4B SPAC in July 2020 and the Social Capital CEO has reserved 26 public tickers for SPAC public offerings. Three notable healthcare SPACs are Hims, Multiplan and Clover.

Deal activity and size have increased over the last quarter in the RCM, HCIT, Data & Analytics space. This breaks the downward trend lasting for over a year now of what appears to be smaller deal sizes with seemingly the same amount of deal activity.



TOP TRANSACTIONS

Total deal size in the third quarter of 2020 was significantly up with a handful of notable deals that happened this quarter.

eSolutions, a provider of revenue cycle management, workflow automation, sophisticated analytics and flexible reporting systems was acquired by **Waystar Health** through an LBO for \$1.35B.

InTouch Health, a developer of a virtual care platform designed to provide high-quality, patient-centric virtual care for

every use case and any clinical setting, was acquired by **Teladoc (NYSE: TDOC)** for \$600mm. The purchase included approximately \$150mm in cash and \$450mm of Teladoc common stock.

GoodRx (NAS: GDRX), a digital healthcare platform that provides prescription drugs at affordable prices, raised \$1.14B in its initial public offering on the Nasdaq stock exchange.

Livongo (NAS: LVGO), a developer of a data science and technology enabled platform for the detection of diabetes, was acquired by **Teladoc (NYSE: TDOC)** for \$18.5B. The purchase included a combination of cash and Teladoc Health common stock.

Amwell (NYSE: AMWL), a telehealth company enable digital delivery of care across the full healthcare continuum, raised \$742mm in its initial public offering on the New York Stock Exchange.

Olive, a developer of process automation software designed to build meaningful artificial intelligence, completed its Series E venture funding round, raising \$157mm. The deal was led by Drive Capital, out of Columbus, Ohio, and General Catalyst.

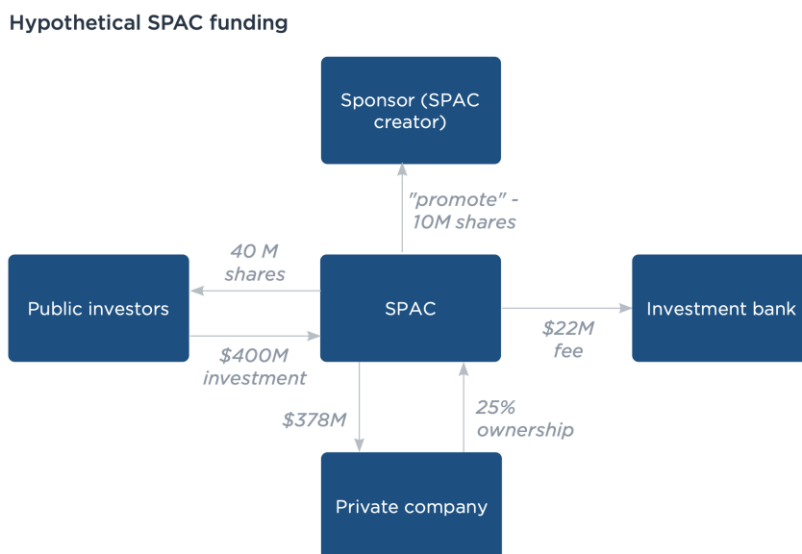

SPACS: WHAT ARE THEY AND WHY ARE THEY RELEVANT NOW?

SPACs or Special Purpose Acquisition Companies are public shell companies that acquire a private company for the purpose of taking it public. SPACs have been around for decades but have become popular in the last 2 years including recent notable Virgin Galactic (NASDAQ: SPCE) and DraftKings (NASDAQ: DKNG). SPACs have already raised over \$40B in 2020, tripling the capital raised in 2019. Once a SPAC goes public, the sponsors begin looking for a company to acquire; the acquisition company can be in any industry, but typically the sponsors identify a target industry before IPO. Sponsors have 2 years to acquire a company or the SPAC is dissolved, and money is returned to the shareholders.

Once the acquisition is approved by shareholders, the sponsors ask existing institutional investors or new outside investors for additional money utilizing a Private Investment in Public Equity (PIPE). After this final capital raise, the SPAC is now ready to take the company public.

SPACs have recently become more popular due to private companies have been staying private for longer periods of time as well as the uncertainty brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. Private companies are unsure of the ability to raise larger rounds but are still looking for capital or liquidity. Another factor is that the traditional IPO process can take years to complete and a SPAC is a faster alternative.

Hims (NYSE: HIMS), a healthcare startup that recently went public via a SPAC, determined that due to increased speed and certainty of a SPAC deal, there were more favorable dynamics for a SPAC over a traditional IPO process. Another factor is the uncertainty of share price, which can cause an IPO to be mispriced, which causes the company to miss out on more money. The SPAC process avoids this altogether but although the company doesn't leave any money on the table, they pay for that luxury in a potential lower valuation than an IPO as well as sponsor fees.

Multiplan (NYSE: MPLN), a provider of healthcare cost management services to manage risks associate with healthcare claims, **Clover Health (NYSE: IPOC – expect name change)**, a patient-centered analytics platform that identifies potential risks and provides preventative care, and **Accountable Healthcare America (NAS: GRNV – expect name change)**, a developer of medical payment systems, are the latest in the line of healthcare companies that have gone public via SPAC. Multiplan received \$2.4B of development capital via PIPE and was acquired via reverse merger by the SPAC Churchill Capital, resulting in the combined entity trading on the NYSE. Clover Health reached an agreement to be acquired at a \$3.7B value by Social Capital via reverse merger and expected to close first quarter of 2021. Accountable Healthcare America is in talks to acquire GreenVision Acquisition via a reverse merger and also expected to close first quarter of 2021.

Other recent SPACs raising capital include Healthcare Services Acquisition (NASDAQ: HCARU), plans to raise \$300M and targeting healthcare services and related industries in the US, BCLS Acquisition Corp. (NASDAQ: BLSA) affiliated with Bain Capital raised \$125M and targeting healthcare or healthcare related businesses, Helix Acquisition Corp (NASDAQ: HLXA) affiliated with Cormorant Asset Management raised \$100M targeting healthcare or healthcare related businesses and Sarissa Capital Acquisition Corp (NASDAQ: SRSA) raised \$175M targeting healthcare and biopharma businesses.

One big question being asked right now is: "Is there too much SPAC money chasing too few opportunities?" Only time will tell and we may not find the answer to this question for at least a few more years.

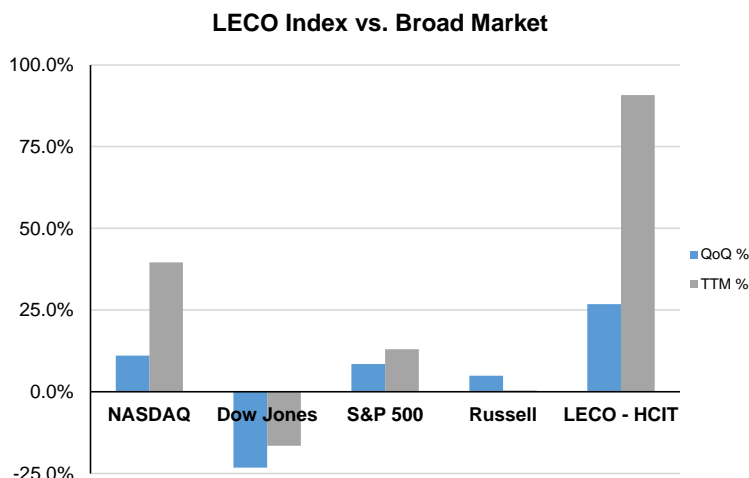

The publicly traded equity markets, outside of the Dow Jones, saw a strong recovery during the second quarter.

The NASDAQ had the best performance of all the indices. This is likely due to a combination of how the index is weighted, and the strong performance of well-capitalized tech stocks. A similar story could be told for the S&P 500, which is also weighted and heavily influenced by the likes of Apple, Google, Amazon, and Facebook.

The Russell is back in the positive on a TTM basis. The reason for its lagging compared to the likes of the S&P 500 and the NASDAQ is likely explained by the nature of the companies in the Russell 2000 index. That is, they are relatively smaller with balance sheets that are not nearly as robust.

The LECO HCIT Index saw another strong performance. This quarter, we saw a 17.3% growth. This is among the top of the indices, outperforming all indices quarterly but only underperforming the NASDAQ by 0.1%

Our top performing company was **Livongo (NAS: LVGO)**. This came after a huge growth in YoY earnings of 703%.
